The Friends of the EPL are excited to announce that we will soon be able to open registration for an Imagination Library in our community.

This service is geared toward children aged birth-5 in Emmet County. Each month a new, carefully selected book will be mailed in

your child's name directly to your home. The first book is always the children's classic The Little Engine That CouldTM. Best of all it is a FREE GIFT to your child through our partnership with The Dollywood Foundation.

When registering children we ask for the child's name, birthdate, mailing address, parent name and cell phone or email address. There are no eligibility requirements outside of being aged 0-5 and living in Emmet County. Our pursuit of establishing this service for the children of our community began with the family of Dennis Ridout. Denny was a long-time member of the EPL Board of Trustees, and his family gave the memorials that were the start of this special fund. Since then, several other memorials, the proceeds of our 2020 Silent Auction, and a grant from the Eldon Wayne Williamson Designated Fund of the Community Foundation of Greater Atlanta have made this project possible.
