The Estherville Public Library will acquire materials that are useful to the general genealogy researchers.

Materials owned by the Genealogical Society will be shelved in the genealogy section of the Estherville Public Library and will be added and discarded at the discretion of the members of the society. Items shelved there are available for in-house use only, unless marked otherwise.

Historical search requests submitted to the library will be researched by one of the staff or forwarded on to a member of the Genealogical Society as time permits. Charges will be assessed for consumables used by library staff as needed. Genealogical Society members may assess a fee for their time, at their discretion.

The Estherville Public Library has available a list of members of the Genealogical Society who will perform research and answer correspondence.

Members of the Genealogical Society receive up to 20 free copies per request, after which normal fees apply.
